Whereas it is necessary to ensure the smooth flow of traffic and to ensure safety of road users on the following internal roads of residential colony of Sarita Vihar ; (1) Main Sarita Vihar road between Pocket 'C' and Pocket 'G' from Madan Pur Khader Road to Road No. 13 A, (2) Road in Janta Flats between Pocket 'M' and Pocket 'L', (3) Road in Pocket 'J' and Pocket 'L'.

And whereas the problem of congestion/traffic jam public safety and causes on the above said internal roads of residential colony, Sarita Vihar due to movement of Heavy/Light Goods Vehicles has assumed serious proportions and is endangering the life of road users.


Now, therefore, I Sanjay Singh, Addl. Deputy Commissioner of Police, Traffic, Delhi in exercise of powers conferred upon me under Regulation 30 (1) of the Delhi Control of Vehicular and other Traffic on Roads and Streets Regulation, 1980, do hereby prohibit the plying of Heavy and Light Goods vehicles on the above said internal roads of residential colony of Sarita Vihar whole day i.e. 24 hours.

This order shall be published for the information of the General Public in the official gazette and by affixing a copy on the Notice Boards of the office of all Distt. Deputy Commissioners of Police and all Police Stations in Delhi/New Delhi.

The concerned civic agency and road maintaining authorities shall erect the corresponding sign boards indicating, the restriction in the area for the information and convenience of all concerned.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
