Whereas it is necessary to ensure the smooth flow of traffic and the safety of various road users on Mathura Road (from Badarpur Border upto Ashram Chowk) and Mehrauli-Badarpur Road.

And whereas the problem of congestion/traffic holds up on Mathura Road (from Badarpur Border upto Ashram Chowk) and Mehrauli-Badarpur Road due to the movement of Heavy and Medium Goods Vehicles has assumed serious proportions and is endangering the life of road users.


Now, therefore, I, M.S. Upadhye, DCP/Traffic, Delhi in exercise of powers conferred upon me under Regulation 30 (1) of the Delhi Control of Vehicular and other Traffic on Roads and Streets Regulations, 1980 do hereby prohibit the plying of Heavy and Medium Goods Vehicles on Mathura Road (from Badarpur Border upto Ashram Chowk) and Mehrauli-Badarpur Road during the peak hours i.e. from 7.30 A.M. to 11.00 A.M. and 5.00 P.M. to 9.30 P.M.

This order shall be published for the information of general public in the official gazette and by affixing a copy of the notice boards of the offices of all Distt. Deputy Commissioners of Police and all Police Stations in Delhi/New Delhi.

The concerned civic agency and road maintaining authorities shall erect the corresponding sign boards indicating the restriction in the area for the information and convenience of all concerned.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
