NOTIFICATION

Whereas it is necessary to ensure for the smooth flow of traffic and safety of Road users at Kapashera crossing to Rajokari Crossing.

And whereas the problem of congestion/traffic holds up at Kapashera crossing to Rajokari crossing, Delhi as the road is narrow and having manifold traffic. It is necessary to regulate the movement of slow moving traffic on roads and to ensure the convenience and safety of life of residents, children and other roads users.

Now, therefore, I, P. Kamaraj, Dy. Commissioner of Police, Traffic, Delhi in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under regulation 30(1) of the Delhi control of vehicular and Other Traffic on Road and Street Regulation 1980 do hereby prohibit the plying of HTVs, LGVs and Commercial Vehicles on Kapashera Crossing to Rajokari crossing for 24 hours.

This order shall be published for the information of the general public in the official gazette and by affixing a copy on the Notice Boards of the offices of all Distt. DCsP and all Police Stations in Delhi/New Delhi.

The concerned civic agency and road maintaining authorities shall erect the corresponding signboards indicating, the restrictions in the area for the information and convenience of all concerned.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
