

TRAFFIC ADVISORY

YOGA PROGRAMME BY PATANJALI YOG SAMITI AT RAJPATH ON JUNE 19, 2016

A Mass Yoga programme is being organized by Patanjali Yog Samiti at Rajpath and both sides of lawns of Rajpath between Man Singh Road and Rafi Marg on June 19, 2016 from 5.00 PM to 9.00 PM.

In order to ensure convenience to general public and smooth flow of traffic, Delhi Police has made elaborate arrangements. The traffic arrangements in brief will be as follows:

Restrictions in New Delhi Area: Following roads will be restricted for movement of traffic during the timings of the function and as per need (except vehicles/buses with Parking labels):-

1. Rajpath – Between Rafi Marg and Man Singh Road.
2. Janpath – Between Moti Lal Nehru Place and Windsor Place.
3. Maulana Azad Road – Between Sunehri Masjid and R/A Man Singh Road.
4. Dr. Rajender Pd. Road – Between Krishi Bhawan and R/A Jaswant Singh Road (Andhra Bhawan)

Timings of Restrictions: 3.00 PM to 10.00 PM

Available Roads:

All roads around the place of function will remain throughout open for movement of traffic, namely:-

Rafi Marg, Raisina Road, Ashoka Road, Man Singh Road, Akbar Road and Moti Lal Nehru Marg.

Note: C-Hexagon roads will also remain open for traffic all the time.

Available North South Corridor: General traffic can cross Rajpath through C-Hexagon Road, Man Singh Road or Rafi Marg.

Available East West Corridors :

1. Rail Bhawan - Windsor Place – Ashoka Road – R/A Jaswant Singh
2. Sunehri Masjid – Motilal Nehru Marg – Akbar Road – R/A Man Singh Road

Access to New Delhi Railway Station: There is no restriction on roads reading to New Delhi Railway Station. People can take following routes:-

1. Via Rafi Marg from Sunihri Masjid R/A Rail Bhawan – Red Cross road – R/A RML.
2. Windsor Place – Janpath – Outer CC Connaught Place – Chelmsford Road.
3. Windsor Place – Firozshah road – Mandi House – Barakhamba Road – Ranjit Singh Flyover – Guru Nanak Chowk – R/A Minto Road – Ajmeri Gate.

Traffic arrangements are for the guidance and convenience of public. Motorists are requested to follow directions of Traffic Police personnel on ground.
