Dussehra will be celebrated all over Delhi on 11th October 2016.

The main venues where Dussehra would be celebrated by burning effigies of Ravan, Kumbhakaran and Meghnad, are as follows:

2.	Dangal Maidan opposite Old Delhi Railway Station
3.	Ram Lila Maidan

6.	AE-Block, Shalimar Bagh
7.	PU Block Pitampura
8.	Raj Park, Sultan Puri
9.	Dussehra Ground opp. Bharti College, Janakpuri
10.	Sector-10, Dwarka
11.	Qutub School Ground Mehrauli
12.	B-2 Block, Safdarjang Enclave
13.	Shakti Mandir, Virat Ground, PS Ambedkar Nagar
14.	Park Near Tigri Colony, Near Sangam Vihar
15.	Janta Flat GTB Hospital, Dilshad Garden
16.	West Jyoti Nagar
17.	Opp. Chand Cinema, Trilok Puri

In addition to the above main venues, effigies will be burnt at several other places also by local residents, RWA's, MWA's etc in various colonies, market areas & open grounds. Some Ramlila committees also take out processions in their localities before burning of the effigies.

Traffic Restrictions:

There shall be restrictions on movement of traffic on **Netaji Subhash Marg, Nishad Raj Marg (New Darya Ganj Road), Jawahar Lal Nehru Marg and Turkman Gate** depending on the crowd situation, after 5.00 P.M.

Instructions to general public

1. The commuters going to New Delhi Railway Station, Old Delhi Railway Station, Nizamuddin Railway Station and ISBT should leave with sufficient time at hand to accommodate possible delays on the route.
2. Avail public transport to help decongestion of roads.
3. Park your vehicles only at designated parking lots.
4. Avoid roadside parking as it causes hindrance to normal flow of traffic.
5. In case any unusual/unidentified object or person is noticed in suspicious circumstances, information should be given to the Police.

In general because of Dussehra celebrations, congestion of traffic is likely to take place on various roads in the NCT of Delhi. Motorists are requested to have patience, observe traffic rules & road discipline and follow directions of traffic personnel deployed for the traffic arrangements. People are requested to plan their journeys in advance to avoid any kind of inconvenience.
