


TRAFFIC ADVISORY

The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in the OA No. 21/2014 in the matter of Vardhaman Kaushik Vs. Union of India & Ors. in its orders dated 07.04.2015, 18.07.2016 and 20.07.2016 has directed that the diesel motor vehicles more than 10 years old shall not be permitted to ply in Delhi. The Transport Department, GNCT of Delhi has provided a list of 1.9 lakhs such diesel motor vehicles to Delhi Traffic Police which are more than 15 years old and have been de-registered by them as per the directions issued by the National Green Tribunal in their orders.

The Delhi Traffic Police shall be prosecuting and impounding such 15 years old de-registered diesel motor vehicles under section 39/192 Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and section 207 Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. All such motor vehicles, towed away by the cranes deployed by Delhi Traffic Police violating the directions of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal shall also be liable for penal action under section 122/177 Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 along with towing charges.

Public is advised to follow the directions of Hon'ble court and traffic advisory in letter and spirit and not ply their diesel motor vehicles of 15 years or more de-registered by Transport Department, GNCT of Delhi, to avoid legal consequences and impounding of their (diesel) motor vehicles as per the directions of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal by officers of Delhi Traffic Police.
